William Commanda, PhD, OC, was born at the beginning of the last century, on the eve of the First World War, on the first reserve created in Canada. He is the longest known guardian of the ancient sacred mnemonic Wampum storytelling and animative record keeping heritage of his "Mamiwinini/Nomad" Algonquin ancestors. He was born of oral heritage, raised in the generic prototype of the Algonquian linguistic tradition, and he spoke multiple dialects. He learned to speak and write in French and English, and storytelling was his forte. He created a global eco-peace community, the Circle of All Nations, and he relied heavily on storytelling, talking circles and other semiotic and semantic mechanisms to advance cross-cultural understanding, bridge-building, information sharing and relational change on environment, social justice, healing and peace issues.
